DEPARTMENTAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MAJOR IN PHILOSOPHY

To complete the major in philosophy, a student must take a minimum of ten courses, at least three of which must be at or above the 300 level, no more than two of which may be at the 100 level, and a colloquium series. Those courses must include:

(chosen from 151 or 158)
- ___ 1 course in metaphysics and epistemology

- ___ 1 course in values
(chosen from 211, 218, 234, 236, 272, 311, 374)
- ___ 1 course in diversity
(chosen from 213, 215, 221, 272, 297 [Indian Philosophy], 311, 312, or a pre-approved course in non-Western philosophy)

DEPARTMENTAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MINOR IN PHILOSOPHY

To complete the minor in philosophy, a student must take a minimum of six courses in philosophy, at least one of which must be at or above the 300 level. The six courses must include:

- ___ one course in the history of Western philosophy
(chosen from 231, 232, 352, 353, 359, 373, 374, or 378)
- ___ one course in metaphysics and epistemology
(chosen from 239, 253, 274, 317, 338, 353, 373, or 376)
- ___ one course in values
(chosen from 211, 218, 234, 236, 272, 311, or 374)
