**ELIJAH PARISH LOVEJOY SUMMER INTERNSHIP  
IN JOURNALISM**

The Goldfarb Center is pleased to announce the creation of the Elijah Parish Lovejoy Summer Internships in Journalism. Under a grant from the John S. and James L. Knight Foundation, the Center is offering three summer internships for summer 2010.

The Center has some contacts in news organizations throughout the nation. We will be willing to work with students in finding appropriate internships, but ultimately whether a student is accepted for an internship or not depends on that student's application, resume, and interview performance. Winning a Lovejoy Summer Journalism Fellowship thus cannot be taken as a guarantee of an internship, though it clearly will give the student a step up. The internships will provide a stipend of \$3000 for each student; the internships will also pay up to \$2000 toward student expenses; it is expected that these internships will last at least eight weeks.

Students interested in applying for the Lovejoy journalism internships for summer 2010 must apply to L. Sandy Maisel, director of the Goldfarb Center, [lsmaisel@colby.edu](mailto:lsmaisel@colby.edu). **All applications must be submitted electronically by 12 p.m. on Friday, December 11th, 2009.** No deadline extensions will be granted. In order to be considered, each application should include:

- ✓ An application letter that includes statements regarding:
  - the applicant's interest in journalism
  - the applicant's experience in journalism
  - a discussion of any specific issues on which the applicant might like to work
  - any preferences regarding type of journalism in which the applicant has interest
  - any preferences regarding location
- ✓ Writing Sample
- ✓ Resume
- ✓ An unofficial transcript
- ✓ Two letters of recommendation: at least one from a professor and one from an employer; these letters must address the elements described in the "Guidelines for Recommenders" available on line at [http://www.colby.edu/academics\\_cs/goldfarb/internships/](http://www.colby.edu/academics_cs/goldfarb/internships/).

**Upon acceptance, recipients of the internship are required to send a headshot and short bio to Susanna Thompson. **Upon completion of the summer internship, students are required to submit a final report of their internship (1-2 pages, single spaced).**
