### **Responsible Conduct of Research Interactive Tutorials**

As a student or faculty member of Colby College, you are asked to complete the Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) interactive tutorials. These interactive modules are designed to fulfill the College's requirement in training of undergraduates and postdoctoral researchers in responsible and ethical conduct as mandated by the National Science Foundation funding agency.

To register, go to: [www.ResponsibleResearch.org](http://www.ResponsibleResearch.org) to sign up for a login account via the new user registration form. You will need to register as a user affiliated with the Colby College group account. There are three modules: Module 1: Rights and Obligations, Module 2: Collaboration, Communication, and Grants Management, and Module 3: Intellectual Property. You may not be required to complete all three of the tutorials, but you will have access to them via the RCR Website. Each module takes approximately one hour to complete and you do not need to finish them all at once. If you log off in the middle of a section, the site will save your place, so that next time you login, you will be able to start where you left off. A designated supervisor of the group account will then see a record of your completed sessions.
