## Location

The clinic will be held at the beautiful 714 acre Colby College Campus. The Colby College baseball and softball fields will be used. Players will have use of the olympic size indoor pool which will be available as well as other recreational facilities in the spacious field house.

## Fundamentals

All fundamentals of baseball will be covered daily in stations focusing on hitting, bunting, baserunning, infield and outfield play, as well as pitching and catching. Every hitter is videotaped. Drills and corrections are provided through the analysis of slow motion video. Pitchers are also taught correct pitching mechanics and techniques through drills and individual instruction.
