Season Outlook

The 2008 team's 18-14 record was a tremendous achievement as only two other teams in the history of the college have amassed more wins. Timely hitting and pitching plus depth at many positions enabled the team to establish momentum in Phoenix during their spring trip. The Mules played consistent quality baseball throughout the season.



The ball club looks forward to 2009 hoping to build on the 18 wins and make the post-season conference tournament. Third year head coach Dale Plummer understands Colby's pitching, defense, team strength and consistent high level of play in conference games must improve to compete for the postseason NESCAC tournament.

Colby returns three of the top 10 hitters in the conference. League leader 1B Ryan Conlon '10 hit (.442), 2b John LaMantia '10 hit (.410), seventh in the league and OF Ken Kaufman, '10 (.392) tenth.

"We have exceptional leadership with our three captains, Craig Cooper, Kyle McKay and Bobby Whelan. Their dedication to the game of baseball and their team have changed the face of Colby baseball for a long time. Our players understand the importance of team first and that loyalty and accountability to one another will allow them to graduate with a very positive experience."



The Mules return nine players who hit .300 or higher, and a pitching staff that accounted for 16 wins and 6 saves.

"Game pitching experience is critical to the success of any staff. The Mules have nine returning pitchers with significant experience over the past couple years, and several freshmen that will contribute on the mound." said Coach Plummer. Matt Moore '10, Justin Clark '09, and Robert Tourek '09, all return as starting pitchers, while Ryan Murphy '11, and Bobby Whelan '09 will be counted on to once again anchor the bullpen.

Colby's baseball team has a strong nucleus to prepare for the 2009 season. With the majority of last season's starters returning and quality of the freshman class brings increased depth and competitiveness to the team.

Baseball at Colby

Established in 1867, the Colby baseball program is one of the College's oldest varsity programs. Jack Coombs, a member of the Class of 1906, was Colby's first of five major league players and went on to a fine career with the Philadelphia Athletics and the Brooklyn Robins. Colby's Coombs Field was completely renovated in 2001 and now possesses an in-ground sprinkler system, drainage, new bleachers, and dugouts. The composition of the field ensures the earliest possible opportunity to play in the spring.

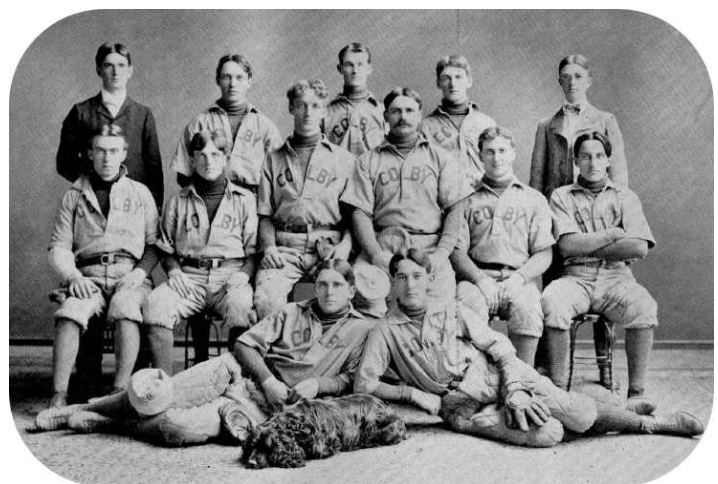
The team is composed of approximately 27 players. Preseason starts February 15, with players practicing in the spacious indoor field house and on the synthetic turf Bill Alford Field until late March when the team takes its annual trip South to compete in 10 games over spring break.

Colby competes in the Eastern Division of New England Small College Athletic Conference, NESCAC and plays three-game series with Bates, Bowdoin, Trinity, and Tufts. The top two teams from the East Division play the top two teams from the West Division for an automatic berth in the NCAA tournament. The Mules also play non-conference games against state rivals University of Maine and University of Southern Maine. League games are played on Fridays and Saturdays and most weekday games are in state to ensure as little missed class time as possible.

In recent years Colby has had many outstanding players recognized by the league with NESCAC All-Conference honors. Tommy Salemy, '07, was named to the NESCAC first team after the 2007 season, Andy Carr '07 was named to the NESCAC first team after the 2006 season, while Nick Spillane '08 was named league Rookie of the Year and earned second-team honors in 2005. Second baseman Andrew Tripp '01, outfielder Jon Lord '02, and catcher Eric Roy '04 all were two-time selections, and Tripp and Lord each earned All-New England honors. Kevin Brunelle '02 was All-NESCAC, while Kristopher Keelty '99 went on to pitch professionally for two seasons. Former pitching ace Galen Carr '97 is currently scouting for the Boston Red Sox.

Most of Colby's current players are active with summer baseball teams. About one-fourth of the team includes two-sport athletes at Colby.

The program gives our student athletes a chance to compete in a great college baseball atmosphere while always keeping the academic mission of the College in focus.

Coombs Field



Coombs Field, home of the baseball team, was completely renovated in September of 2001. Improvements included a sod infield with a modern irrigation system and a new surface for the entire outfield. The field measures 335 feet down the left-field line, 340 feet down the right-field line, and 380 in straightaway center field. Ample parking and seating is provided.

Athletic Center



A \$6-million renovation to the Harold Alfond Athletic Center gave Colby one of the finest facilities in the Northeast, and recent reconstruction projects have upgraded playing fields and tennis courts. The athletic center includes the 3,000-seat Wadsworth Gymnasium; the Alfond Ice Arena; a field house with four indoor tennis courts, a 220-yard track, room for indoor practices, and a climbing wall; five international glass-backed Dunaway Squash Courts; the Carl Nelson Physical Therapy Center; a 25-yard by 25-meter pool; and a spacious aerobics and dance studio. Outdoors there are 50 acres of playing fields, including the lighted Bill Alfond Field (synthetic field), a lighted practice field, an all-weather 400-meter track, 10 outdoor tennis courts, and the 8.5-mile Campbell Cross Country Trails.

Boulos Family Fitness Center

The 5,300-square-foot Boulos Family Fitness Center offers Nautilus, Stairmaster, Gravitron, Bodymaster, and lifecycle (regular & recumbent) machines, stepmills, stairclimbing machines, treadmills, squat racks and a full range of free weights. The center was designed with high ceilings, a stretch area, a window bench, water fountains and open ventilation. Directly upstairs is an aerobic studio with hardwood flooring and an ergometer training area. Both levels overlook the field house with its indoor track and tennis courts.





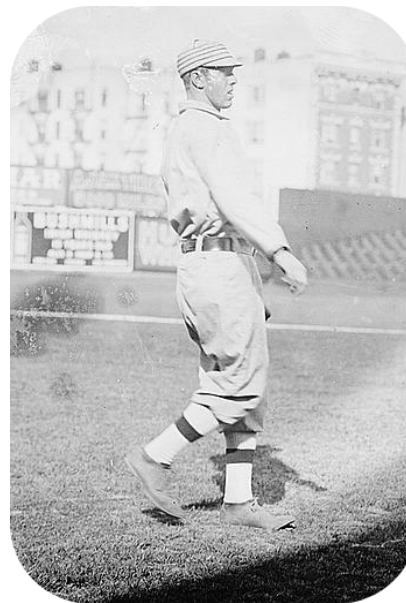

NESCAC



Founded in 1971, the New England Small College Athletic Conference (NESCAC) is a group of eleven highly selective liberal arts colleges and universities that share a similar philosophy for intercollegiate athletics. The Conference was created out of a concern for the direction of intercollegiate athletic programs, and remains committed to keeping a proper perspective on the role of sport in higher education.



The formation of NESCAC originated with an agreement among Amherst College, Bowdoin College, Wesleyan University and Williams College first drafted in 1955. Along with these four institutions, Bates College, Colby College, Hamilton College, Middlebury College, Trinity College and Tufts University are sustaining charter members. Connecticut College joined in 1982, bringing the Conference's membership to its current total of 11 institutions.

NESCAC members believe intercollegiate athletic programs should operate in harmony with the educational mission of each institution. The Conference is committed to establishing common boundaries to keep athletics strong but in proportion to the overall academic mission of the member institutions. In pursuit of this mission, the Presidents of each NESCAC institution control intercollegiate athletic policy. Conference tenets are usually more restrictive than those of the NCAA Division III with regard to season length, number of contests and post-season competition.

NESCAC institutions also believe athletic teams should be representative of the entire student body. Thus, admissions and financial policies are consistent with the NCAA Division III policies that prohibit athletic scholarships and award financial aid solely on the basis of need.

In 1999, the NESCAC formally became a playing conference and now sponsors 26 conference championship sports (13 for men and 13 for women). Member schools offer extensive and broad based intercollegiate as well as club and intramural opportunities for both men and women. With member institutions sponsoring an average of nearly 30 varsity programs, NESCAC provides more than 7,500 opportunities for participation in intercollegiate competition at the Division III level. Teams and individuals have achieved great success on both a regional and national level. During the 2007-08 academic year, 54 teams participated in NCAA team championships. NESCAC student-athletes claimed 22 individual national championships and NESCAC teams won seven national team championships.
