- The C– requirement for EC133, EC134, and calculus is effective as of the Class of 2018.
- For students considering Ph.D. level graduate study in economics we recommend: EC336 (Mathematical Economics); MA122 or MA162; MA253 (Linear Algebra); MA274 (Mathematical Reasoning); MA311 (Ordinary Differential Equations); MA338 (Real Analysis); and CS151 (Computational Thinking).
- EC221 is for non-majors only. If EC223 is completed prior to declaring the managerial economics minor, EC221 is not required. Students who have completed EC221 and subsequently decide to major in economics must complete EC223 and may count EC221 toward their elective course requirement.
- EC393 is a pre-requisite or concurrent requirement for all senior seminars.
- No economics courses listed for the majors or minor may be taken satisfactory/unsatisfactory.
