They will serve as the primary student contact for any Colby Museum video needs and are expected to carry out duties without supervision. Candidates must have flexible hours as events are held during the day, evening, and on weekends. The ideal candidate should have a strong technical knowledge of video production (including audio recording and video editing). Preference will be given to those who own equipment and have taken or are taking relevant courses. Candidates should be able to provide a link to their work on a website or online portfolio.
