

Colby College Special Programs Summer 2006 Student Housing Application

Deadline for submitting forms is Monday May 1, 2006. **N.B.** Housing is limited this summer and students submitting forms past the deadline are not guaranteed housing.

Summer housing is available from Sunday May 28 to Sunday August 13, 2006 at a cost of \$55 per week including a fourteen-meal plan. You may live on campus from 48 hours before your job starts to 48 hours after your job ends but no earlier or later than the dates specified. You may begin moving your belongings into your summer room before May 22 IF your room is ready. If living on campus in the fall, you may begin moving your belongings into your fall room as early as Thursday afternoon August 10 if your room is available. Students will live in the Taylor, Sturtevent and Leonard this year.
