



**SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT
Colby College Health Plan
August 3, 2017**

This is a summary of the annual report of the Colby College Health Plan, EIN 01-0211497, Plan No. 501, for the period January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

President & Trustees of Colby College has committed itself to pay certain employee assistance program claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company and affiliates and Vision Service Plan to pay health and vision claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2016 were \$10,540,965.

Because they are so called "experience-rated" contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2016, the premiums paid under such "experience-rated" contracts were \$9,591,917 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these contracts during the plan year was \$8,056,368.
