### **Summary**

Next, we will bridge to the later sessions, and use the precepts as a bridging tool: The faculty have the handout on the survey results that they have been updating and making notes on. Now we give them the precepts. How do they match? Should precepts be added or deleted? Are these precepts the right ones..the foundational statements for a set of distribution requirements...?

Finally, we have a good sense of the models that are out there. The models are built from different pieces of the knowledge, skills, and values we have been discussing. Potentially we could have skills based, breadth based, values based, common experience, vs academic freedom models. How do we present that to the faculty?
