### GUIDELINES, RULES, & PROCEDURES

- All persons working in the Small Crafts area must have the approval of the Department of Performance, Theater, and Dance Costume Shop Manager.
  - Know the location of the nearest first-aid kit and fire alarm pull boxes.
  - Know the location of the nearest fire extinguisher and how to use it.
  - All use of Department equipment must be cleared with Department of Performance, Theater, and Dance Costume Shop Manager
  - If unsure of or have never used equipment you must speak with Department of Performance, Theater, and Dance Costume Shop Manager
  - Look at MSDS sheets for the product before using
  - All spray paint or spray adhesive must be used in the Spray Booth
  - The space used must be cleaned before when you have finished for any period of time, and all 'wet' project must be stored in appropriate 'drying' location
