

STUDIO ART MAJOR CHECKLIST (11 courses) Name:

Studio concentration (4 courses)

Concentration of four courses in a single medium (photography, painting, printmaking, sculpture, or digital media).

Studio electives (2 courses)

Two additional studio courses in or outside of your area of concentration (only one 100-level studio course can count toward the major).

Art History (3 courses)*

100-level art history course _____

One course focused on modern/contemporary art history at the 100 or 200 level** _____

One additional art history course at the 200 level or above

* Note that AR110 and AR117 do not fulfill this major requirement.

** Modern/contemporary is defined as art ca. 1850 to the present. Photography concentrators must take one history of photography course (AR285, AR288, or AR316).

Studio Capstone (2 courses, 4 credits total)

This biweekly seminar is taken in the fall and spring of the senior year. Each course must be taken in conjunction with a studio course in the area of concentration. Required for all studio art majors to participate in the Senior Art Exhibition.
