### OVERVIEW

The STS minor has the option of taking one of two tracks, both of 7 courses.

Track 1: Socio-Cultural (for majors in humanities, interdisciplinary studies, and social sciences):

- 1 introductory course (ST112: Introduction to STS)
- 5 electives (ST- or ST-approved courses)
- 1 senior seminar (ST4xx)

Track 2: Human Dimensions of Science (for majors in natural science):

- 1 introductory course (ST112: Introduction to STS)
- 3 electives (ST- or ST-approved courses)
- 2 -course thematic cluster containing at least 1 300-level or higher natural science, computer science, or mathematics course plus any other course. The cluster must be proposed to (by email) and approved by the STS Chair. One paper or project conducted in the senior seminar must address social and cultural implications of the thematic cluster.
- 1 senior seminar (ST4xx)

### STIPULATIONS

- All courses not listed or cross-listed ST- in the catalogue must be from the approved courses list to count for STS credit
- Courses taken abroad require the approval of the STS director. No more than 2 courses for a semester abroad or 4 courses for a year abroad may be counted toward the major.
- No more than 2 100-level courses beyond ST112 may be counted toward the major.
